

Medical Check-up

Frequently Asked Questions on Rotary

What is Rotary?

Rotary is the world's oldest service club organization. Its made up of more than 32,000 Rotary clubs in nearly 170 countries. The members of these autonomous clubs are called Rotarians, and they form a global network of 1.2 million business and professional leaders, all volunteering their time and talents to serve their communities and the world. Individual Rotary clubs, in turn, belong to the global association Rotary International.

How many clubs are there in Rotary?

Rotary has over 32,000 Rotary clubs worldwide.

How many members are there worldwide?

There are more than 1.2 million Rotarians worldwide.

How to become a Member?

Often, a person being considered for membership is invited by a club member, or sponsor, to attend one or more club meetings to learn more about Rotary. In this case, the sponsor submits the name of the candidate

to the club's membership committee.

What are the responsibilities of membership?

Members are expected to attend weekly club meetings. Members must pay annual dues to their clubs, their Rotary district, and Rotary International. Members are expected to participate in local or international activities or projects of the Rotary club. Clubs encourage members to aspire to leadership or committee roles within their clubs.

What are the attendance requirements?

An attendance record of 60 percent is required to remain an active Rotarian. Any missed meeting must be made up within 14 days before or after the regular meeting. To accommodate busy schedules, there are various opportunities to make up missed meetings.

- 3) Four former prime ministers of republic of Korea (south Korea) have been members of the Rotary Club of Hanyang - Chang Soon Yoo, Choong Hoon Park, Chung Yui Kim & Duck Woo Nam.
