Loving, caring, kind and bundle of Joy are some of the adjectives that describe our own poliowarrior Harshsudan Purecha.

Famous Ralph Waldo Emerson has said that..

"To laugh often and much; to win the respect of intelligent people and the affection of children...to leave the world a better place...to know even one life has breathed easier because you have lived. This is to have succeeded..."

Sudanbhai had not only lived a very successful life but also excelled in human relation aspect of life. His motto of "laugh and make others laugh" had won him many friends in business and Rotary. His business of placing poor people on a gulf assignment had helped many poor families earn their livelihood and prosper.

He was a true and one of the most active Rotarians of R C Borivli having contributed with "tan, man and dhan" for community service projects. His jovial nature and love for kids attracted him to take up the task of eradicating polio during my presidential tenure in 2008-09. He created milestones in immunizing more than 4000 children in 2008-09 and further broke the record by immunizing 5000 children in 2009-10. His commitment and dedication for this cause was unparalleled. It was disheartening that he was not there to lift the Polio trophy accorded to our club at Discon 2011 for the wonderful work done by him and his team during 2009-10 in eradicating polio from Borivli.

He was "Jaan" of every fellowship meeting and especially club picnics. His unassuming sense of humor and wit will be missed immensely at club meetings, fellowship programs and picnics.

His daughter Vaishakhi and wife Smita are part of RC Borivli family. We all pray to almighty to give them courage and strength to bear this colossal loss.

We all have lost a dear friend, Rotarian and a fantastic human being but I am sure you will agree that "Anand" of our club will live for ever in our hearts. "Anand" mara Nahin Karte.
